EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE GENERAL DISCUSSION August 7th, 2018 5:30 P.M.

While performing the regular audit the auditors have some judgment with regards to what a finding is. For the AUP audit there is a list of questions to be answered and there is no leeway. The AUP's are best practices that the legislative auditor is looking for. If they can be achieved then that is the goal, but in some cases that is not possible.

Michael Statham stated that there was nothing overall in the AUP's that rose to the level of a finding. In some cases, the AUP's highlight a problem that could result in a finding, but nothing was discovered.
