EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE GENERAL DISCUSSION January 12th, 2017 – 4:30 P.M.

It is his recommendation that the projects be submitted with the following priorities (1) UPDC Wind Retrofit Project; (2) UP Court House Wind Retrofit Project II; (3) Scotts Hideaway Road; (4) Dean Road; (5) Williams Colony Road; (6) River Road; (7) UP Infrastructure Damage Mitigation in the Bayou D'Arbonne Watershed and (8) Improvements to eliminate flooding on Rocky Branch Road. Motion Mr. Taylor, seconded by Mr. Hutto to authorize the projects listed to be submitted for the Hazard Mitigation Grant Program. Projects to be submitted in the priority order listed above. Motion carried unanimously.

A brief discussion was held concerning the possible subdivision behind D'Arbonne Village. There are concerns that the subdivision is going to be in a flood zone. Concerns were also expressed that the jury has not been contacted regarding the subdivision ordinance. The Secretary/Treasurer will set up a meeting with Mr. Sanson, Bruce Hampton, Glenn Hutto and David Dumas.
