

REGULAR MEETING UNION PARISH POLICE JURY

Farmerville, Louisiana
September 3, 2019

The Union Parish Police Jury met this date in regular session in the Police Jury meeting room, Courthouse Annex, Farmerville, Louisiana with the following present: Charles Sawyer, Lanny Parker, Jerry W. Taylor, Glenn Hutto, Ben Bridges, Nathan Futch, Stan Smith, Mike Jones and John Watley. Absent: None. Also present was Tracy Houck, Assistant District Attorney. The President called the session to order and welcomed all guests. Mr. Watley offered the invocation and Mr. Bridges led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

President Taylor welcomed the visitors in the audience and asked if anyone in the audience would like to register for public comment. The public was given the opportunity to comment on any item shown on the agenda.

The Secretary/Treasurer announced that a Special meeting will be held on September 19, 2019 @ 6:00 PM. This meeting will be a public hearing for the Union Parish Assessor's Board of Review.

Mr. Taylor would like to remember Calvin Hollis and continue praying for him. Mr. Hollis was involved in a serious vehicle accident last week. Mr. Hollis is still in the hospital. Connor Garlington was also involved in the wreck and he is also still in the hospital. Both gentlemen will have a long recovery.

Mr. Sawyer would like to remember the family of Lavelle Maine who recently passed away. Mr. Maine was a City Alderman for several years and a close friend.

After the opportunity for public comment was given, a Motion was made by Mr. Hutto, seconded by Mr. Bridges and declared adopted by unanimous roll call vote of the Jury to approve the agenda as written.

Motion Mr. Parker, seconded by Mr. Sawyer to adopt the minutes of the August 6, 2019 regular meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

The Secretary/Treasurer presented the Budget to Actual Revenue and Expense report for the month of August and explained to the jurors that the report reflects what has been budgeted for the year compared to what has been spent. The Secretary/Treasurer then presented a brief financial report. The month of August had three pay periods therefore payroll expenses are higher for August. The parish spent \$25,600 out of the General Fund housing juveniles @ Green Oaks Detention Center. Last month that figure was \$20,000. This year to date the parish has spent \$107,200 housing juveniles. That is money that could be utilized elsewhere.

In the Detention Center Fund the Transitional Work Release Program (TWP) generated \$174,808.53 for the month of August. This is the largest amount that the work release program has generated, but keep in mind that the work release inmates also had three pay periods. That is an increase of \$93,864.01 from last month. Income for the DOC inmates totaled \$210,612.23 which is an increase of \$28,441.70 from last month. There are 103 active inmates participating in the work release program and as a whole the Detention Center is at capacity.

The Secretary/Treasurer reported that she has begun the budget process and will be meeting with each department head regarding their wants and needs. At this point in the year we should have expended about 67% of the total budget. **Motion Mr. Parker, seconded by Mr. Hutto to adopt the Revenues and Expenditures Report for the month of August 2019. Motion carried unanimously.**

Motion Mr. Bridges, seconded by Mr. Futch to accept the precinct description provided by Doug Mitchell with North Delta Regional Authority to merge the Western boundary of Precinct 4A into Precinct 4. Said property description is provided in Ordinance 894 below. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion Mr. Parker, seconded by Mr. Bridges to accept the precinct description provided by Doug Mitchell with North Delta Regional Authority to correct the property descriptions in Precincts 24 and 27. Motion carried unanimously.

ORDINANCE # 894

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE PROSPECTIVE PRECINCTS BY THE SPLIT AND/OR MERGER OF PRECINCT GEOGRAPHY IN ACCORDANCE WITH LOUISIANA REVISED STATUTES 18:532 AND 18:532.1

WHEREAS, the Union Parish Police Jury has the authority under R.S. 18:532 to adopt prospective precinct mergers that are not subject to the requirement that the precincts or parts of the precincts shall be in the same state, local, and municipal office voting district, and:

WHEREAS, any prospective precinct mergers shall be submitted for review and approval to the Louisiana Secretary of State and the Louisiana Legislature by December 31 of 2019, and:

WHEREAS, any prospective precinct mergers shall be effective not later than **March 31 of 2020** for the purpose of establishing block boundaries for the federal decennial census, and for reapportionment and redistricting purposes following that federal decennial census, and:

WHEREAS, any prospective precinct mergers shall be effective not later than **July 1, 2021** for all purposes, and:

WHEREAS, the Union Parish Police Jury has the authority under R.S. 18:532.1 to change the configuration, boundaries or designation of its election precincts, and:

WHEREAS, the Louisiana Secretary of State and the Louisiana Legislature have approved the merger and/or split of precincts in Section 1, and:

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Union Parish Police Jury, that the following precincts are created by merger and/or splitting, as described in Section 1:

Precinct 1

The incorporated boundaries of Junction City, Louisiana.

Precinct 2

The point of beginning being the intersection of the corporate boundaries of Junction City, Louisiana and the Union Parish Boundary; thence proceed in a easterly direction along said Union Parish Boundary to its confluence with Little Corney Bayou; thence proceed in a southeasterly direction along Little Corney Bayou to its confluence with and un-named creek; thence northerly along said creek to its intersection with John Lewis Rd.; thence easterly along John Lewis Rd. to its intersection with New Hope Church Rd.; thence southerly along New Hope Church Rd. to its intersection with La. State Hwy 15; thence easterly along La. Hwy 15 to its intersection with Walter Rd.; thence southerly along Walter Rd. to its intersection with Barnes Bridge Rd.; thence southerly along Barnes Bridge Rd. to its intersection with Pisgah Church Rd.; thence northerly along Pisgah Church Rd. to its intersection with Grafton Xing.; thence westerly and southerly along Grafton Xing to its intersection with La. State Hwy 2 Alt.; thence westerly along La State Hwy 2 Alt. to its intersection with Busby Rd.; thence southerly along Busby Rd. to its intersection with Chip Mill Rd.; thence westerly along Chip Mill Rd. to its intersection with Ward Line Rd.; thence westerly along Ward Line Rd. to its intersection with the Union Parish Boundary; thence northerly along said boundary to its intersection with Junction City corporate boundary; thence easterly and northerly along the Junction City Corporate Boundary and back to the point of beginning.

Precinct 3

The point of beginning being the intersection of U.S. Highway 167 South and 3rd Street; thence southerly on U.S. Highway 167 Street to Louisiana Highway 2; thence easterly on

Louisiana Highway 2 to Cedar Street; thence southerly on Cedar Street to 5th Street; thence westerly on 5th Street to Louisiana Highway 2 and continue westerly along Louisiana Highway 2 to Van Roach Rd.; thence north along Van Roach Rd. to its intersection with Chip Mill Rd.; thence east along Chip Mill Rd. to its intersection with Busby Rd.; thence northerly along Busby Rd. to its intersection with State Highway 2 Alt. (Summerfield Highway); thence easterly along State Highway 2 Alt. (Summerfield Highway) to its intersection with Holly St.; thence southerly along Holly St. to its intersection with 3rd Street; thence westerly along 3rd Street and back to the point of beginning.

Precinct 4

The point of beginning being the intersection of northern boundary of Union Parish and Little Corney Bayou; thence, southeasterly along Little Corney Bayou to Steep Bank Creek; thence, northerly and easterly along Steep Bank Creek to John Lewis Road; thence, easterly along John Lewis Road to New Hope Church Road; thence, southerly along New Hope Church Road to La. Highway 15; thence, easterly along La. Highway 15 to Wilber Road; thence, southeasterly along Wilber Road to Walter Road; thence, southerly along Walter Road to Barnes Bridge Road; thence, southeasterly along Barnes Bridge Road to Holley Road; thence, easterly along Holley Road to Spearsville Road; thence, southeasterly along Spearsville Road to La. Highway 550; thence, northeasterly along La. Highway 550 to Bayou de Loutre; thence, northwesterly along Bayou de Loutre to the northern boundary of Union Parish; thence, westerly along the northern boundary to the point of beginning.

Precinct 5

The point of beginning being the Union Parish Boundary and Ward Line Rd.; thence easterly along Ward Line Rd. to its intersection with Van Roach Rd.; thence south along Van Roach Rd. to its intersection with La State Hwy 2; thence easterly along La. State Hwy 2 to its intersection with Cedar St.; thence north along Cedar St. to its intersection with 5th St.; thence westerly along 5th St. to its intersection with Cherry St.; thence north along Cherry St. to its intersection with 3rd St.; thence east along 3rd St. to its intersection with Holly St.; thence north along Holly St.; thence north along Holly St. to its intersection with Pisgah Church Rd.; thence easterly and northerly along Pisgah Church Rd. to its intersection with Pisgah Church Circle; thence easterly along Pisgah Church Circle to its intersection with Village Creek Rd.; thence southeasterly along Village Creek Rd. to its intersection with Clyde Colvin Rd.; thence southerly along Colvin Rd. to its intersection with La. State Hwy 550; thence easterly along La. State Hwy 15 to its confluence with Mill Creek; thence southwesterly along Mill Creek to its confluence with Corney Bayou/Lake D'Arbonne; thence northwesterly along Corney Bayou to its confluence with an un-named creek; thence northwesterly along said un-named creek to its intersection with Pleasant Hill Rd.; thence northerly along Pleasant Hill Rd. to its intersection with Thomas Wade Rd.; thence westerly along Thomas Wade Rd. to its intersection with George Johnikin Rd.; thence northerly along George Johnikin Rd and back to the point of beginning.

Precinct 8

The point of beginning being the intersection of La. State Hwy 550 and Bayou DeLoutre; thence northwesterly along Bayou DeLoutre to its intersection with the Union Parish Boundary; thence east along the Union Parish Boundary to its intersection with Oakland Bridge Rd.; thence southerly along Oakland Bridge Rd. to its intersection with La. State Hwy 550; thence southerly along La. State Hwy 550 and back to the point of beginning.

Precinct 9

The point of beginning being the intersection of Bayou DeLoutre and La. State Hwy 550; thence northerly along La State Hwy 550 to its intersection with Oakland Bridge Rd.;

thence northerly along Oakland Bridge Rd. to its intersection with the Union Parish Boundary; thence east along the Union Parish Boundary to its confluence with an un-named creek; thence southerly along said un-named creek to its confluence with Little Bayou DeLoutre; thence southerly along Little Bayou DeLoutre to its confluence with Bayou DeLoutre; thence northerly along Bayou DeLoutre and back to the point of beginning.

Precinct 10

The point of beginning being the intersection of an un-named creek and the Union Parish Boundary; thence east along the Union Parish Boundary to its intersection with La. State Hwy 549; thence southerly along La. State Hwy 549 to its intersection with La. State Hwy 551; thence southerly along La. State Hwy 551 to its confluence with an un-named creek; thence southerly along said un-named creek to its confluence with Big Cane Creek; thence southerly along Big Cane Creek to its confluence with Bayou DeLoutre; thence westerly along Bayou DeLoutre to its confluence with Little Bayou DeLoutre; thence northerly along Little Bayou DeLoutre to its confluence with an un-named creek; thence northerly along said un-named creek and back to the point of beginning.

Precinct 11

WHEREAS, the governing authority of the District has requested that this Police Jury, acting as the governing authority of the Parish of Union, State of Louisiana, give its consent and authority for the District to hold the aforesaid election, and in the event that the election carries to continue to levy and collect the special tax and to continue to levy and collect the service charge provided for therein; and

WHEREAS, as required by Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, it is now the desire of this Police Jury to approve the holding of said election and in the event that the election carries, to continue to levy and collect the special tax and to continue to levy and collect the service charge provided for therein;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Police Jury of the Parish of Union, State of Louisiana, acting as the governing authority of said Parish, that:

SECTION 1. In compliance with the provisions of Article VI, Section 15 of the Constitution of the State of Louisiana of 1974, and in accordance with the request of the Board of Commissioners of Spearsville Fire District of Union Parish, Louisiana, this Police Jury hereby approves the holding of an election in the District, on Saturday, November 16, 2019, at which election there will be submitted the following propositions, to-wit:

**PROPOSITION NO. 1 OF 2
(MILLAGE RENEWAL)**

Shall Spearsville Fire District of Union Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy a six (6) mills tax on all the property subject to taxation in the District (an estimated \$28,200 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of the tax for an entire year), for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2020 and ending with the year 2029, for the purpose of acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating fire protection facilities and

equipment, including fire trucks, in the District, including the cost of obtaining water for fire protection purposes?

**PROPOSITION NO. 2 OF 2
(SERVICE CHARGE RENEWAL)**

Shall Spearsville Fire District of Union Parish, Louisiana (the "District"), be authorized to continue to levy and collect an annual service charge of Fifty Dollars (\$50) from persons owning residential or commercial structures, whether occupied or unoccupied located wholly or partly within the boundaries of the District, for a period of ten (10) years, beginning with the year 2020 and ending with the year 2029 (an estimated \$28,000 reasonably expected at this time to be collected from the levy of said service charge for an entire year), for the costs of any fire protection and emergency services, and for the purposes of assessing and collecting said service charge, owners shall be charged for each such structure which they own, each residential, commercial, occupancy or tenant unit in a structure shall be considered a separate structure and a mobile home, as defined in R.S. 9:1149.2(3), shall be considered a structure, all as provided in the applicable provisions of R.S. 40:1502.1?

SECTION 2. In the event the election carries, this Police Jury does hereby further consent to and authorize the District to continue to levy and collect the special tax and to continue to levy and collect the service charge provided for therein.




