

**INSURANCE COMMITTEE  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
November 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020  
4:00 P.M.**

Present: Brenda Abercrombie, L.W. Nolan and Ceis Nyegaard. Absent: Curtis Moses. Also present was Megan Dunn with Dunn & Dunn Insurance, Johnny Buckley, John Watley and Ben Bridges.

Mrs. Abercrombie called the meeting to order. Mr. Bridges led the group in prayer.

**Motion Mr. Nolan, seconded by Mr. Nyegaard and declared adopted by unanimous roll call vote of the Committee to approve the agenda as written. Motion carried unanimously.**

**Motion made by Mr. Nyegaard, seconded by Mr. Nolan and declared adopted by unanimous vote to approve the minutes of the October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.**

Megan Dunn, Dunn & Dunn Insurance, addressed the Committee concerning the group health insurance. Mrs. Dunn refreshed the committee with what the current Blue Cross plan offers. The current plan has a \$500 deductible and pays 80%/20% in network and 60%/40% out of network. The out of pocket maximum for an individual is \$3,750. The Blue Cross plan currently costs \$726.67 and will increase by 5% to \$767.36. Mrs. Dunn informed the committee that Vantage and United Health Care declined to submit a bid because both companies could not be competitive. The Police Jury Association (CCMSI) can not compete with these benefits. The lowest deductible they have is \$750 and their premium is \$891. Mrs. Dunn presented two Blue Cross options. Plan A has a \$1,000 deductible and co-pays. Plan B has a \$1,000 deductible and no co-pays. **Motion Mr. Nolan, seconded by Mr. Nyegaard to recommend to the full jury to stay with the current Blue Cross Blue Shield plan, authorize the increase in premiums from \$726.67 to \$767.36 and authorize the President and/or Secretary/Treasurer to sign any necessary documents. Motion carried unanimously.**

**There being no further business to come before the committee, Mrs. Abercrombie declared the meeting adjourned upon motion by Mr. Nolan and duly seconded by Mr. Nyegaard on this the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of November, 2020.**
