## LANDFILL COMMITTEE MINUTES OF MEETING August 5<sup>th</sup>, 2025 3:45 P.M.

Present: Ben Bridges, Brenda Abercrombie, Mike Holley and Nathan Pilgreen. Absent: None. Also present: Curtis Moses, Glenn Hutto, Russell Wade, Andrew Ford, Jr., Milas Davidson, Justin Echols, Danielle Harkins and Linda Hammett.

Mr. Bridges called the meeting to order. Mr. Holley led the group in prayer.

Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mrs. Abercrombie to approve the agenda as written. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion Mr. Holley, seconded by Mr. Pilgreen to approve the minutes of the March 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

A brief discussion was held regarding tipping fees. Jon Fourrier prepared a list of landfills across the state and what they are charging for Industrial, Household and C&D waste. Mr. Fourrier also provided calculations based on tonnage amounts across the scales and what the Landfill should be charging to break even. This matter will be discussed at a later date. **No action taken**.

The Secretary/Treasurer presented a contract for charging tipping fee customers. The contract is a Landfill Service Agreement and covers the following:

- Types of waste to be dumped
- Term of the agreement one year
- Fees and payment
- Waste Material Restrictions
- Termination Either party may terminate with 30 days written notice

Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mrs. Abercrombie to recommend to the full jury to adopt a Landfill Contract for all dumpers and container rental customers. Motion carried unanimously.

A discussion was held regarding a policy for charge accounts. The policy covers the following:

- Credit application
- Approval of accounts
- Late payment fees
- When charging privileges are suspended
- Container rental

Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mrs. Abercrombie to recommend to the full jury to adopt the Landfill Charge Account Policy. Motion carried unanimously.

A brief discussion was held concerning the leachate pump control panel. Mr. Echols reported in his email that an electrician is looking for a used contact switch. The pump panel is old and finding an old part has not been feasible. **No action taken**.

A brief discussion was held regarding a hot water pressure washer to be used at the Landfill. The washer would be portable and used to clean the compactors on the hill. Motion Mrs. Abercrombie, seconded by Mr. Pilgreen to recommend to the full jury to purchase a Heated 500 Gallon Pressure Washer Trailer from EnviroServices to be used at the Landfill. Motion carried unanimously.

A discussion was held on the reclassification of James Greg Hand and Harvey Ellis. They are operating the compactors and both will be re-classified as Heavy Equipment Operators. Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mrs. Abercrombie to recommend to the full jury to reclassify James Greg Hand and Harvey Ellis as Heavy Equipment Operators and adjust their pay accordingly. Motion carried unanimously.

The Secretary/Treasurer gave a brief update on the Landfill Gas Beneficial Reuse Project. RNGP has not made the \$250,000 payment. The project engineer is aware of the non-payment. **No action taken**.

There being no more business to come before the committee, Mr. Bridges declared the meeting adjourned upon motion by Mrs. Abercrombie and duly seconded by Mr. Pilgreen on this the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2025.
