

**ROAD COMMITTEE  
MINUTES OF MEETING  
December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2025  
4:30 P.M.**

Present: Mike Holley, Russell Wade, Nathan Pilgreen and Curtis Moses. Absent: None.  
Also present: Glenn Hutto, Ben Bridges, Russell Wade, Brenda Abercrombie, A.J. Ford, Jr.,

Mr. Holley called the meeting to order. Mr. Wade led the group in prayer.

Public Comment on agenda items – No comments were made.

**Motion Mr. Wade, seconded by Mr. Pilgreen and declared adopted by unanimous vote of the Committee to approve the agenda with the following additions:**

- **Ruggs Bluff Road – 25 MPH and Children at Play sign**
- **Magnolia Road – 25 MPH**

**Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mr. Wade to approve the minutes of the November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.**

A brief discussion was held regarding the tractor/trailer bids. The bids were opened Monday, December 1<sup>st</sup> @ 10:00 AM. Three bids were submitted:

Mr. Holley stated that Lone Star in Shreveport did not bid the trailer according to specs. The specs called for a 26' dump trailer instead of a 32' dump trailer which disqualifies Lone Star.  
**Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mr. Wade to recommend to the full jury to accept the bid from Bruckner's in the amount of \$210,663 and authorize the Secretary/Treasurer to issue a purchase order. Motion carried unanimously.**

A brief discussion was held regarding a three (3) year road program (2026, 2027 and 2028). Paul Riley with Riley and Company addressed the Committee regarding the list of roads and how many miles the jury could do in three (3) years. Mr. Riley provided a suggested priority lists that includes the jury chip sealing 41.80 miles of road over a three (3) year period.

**Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mr. Moses to recommend to the full jury to accept the three (3) year Union Parish Police Jury Priority Program above; approval for this three-year program approves the 2026 Road Program to be designed. Future yearly plans can change each year depending on available funds. Proposed budgets shown for years 2027 and 2028 are subject to change. Motion carried unanimously.**

A brief discussion was held regarding 25 MPH speed limits on Ruggs Bluff Road and Magnolia Road. Mr. Bridges is also requesting a “Children at Play” sign on Ruggs Bluff Road. **Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mr. Wade to recommend to the full jury to enact a 25 MPH speed limit on Ruggs Bluff Road in its entirety and place a “Children at Play” sign on the road. Motion carried unanimously.**

**Motion Mr. Pilgreen, seconded by Mr. Moses to recommend to the full jury to enact a 25 MPH speed limit on Magnolia Road in its entirety. Motion carried unanimously.**

**There being no more business to come before the committee, Mr. Holley declared the meeting adjourned upon motion by Mr. Wade and duly seconded by Mr. Moses on this the 2<sup>nd</sup> day of December, 2025.**
